Bluetongue declaration for movement of animals to Great Britain, Channel Islands and Isle of Man

(To be completed and attached to the veterinary certificate where transport to Great Britain, Channel Islands or Isle of Man includes, even for part of the journey, transit through a bluetongue restricted territory based in the transporter's declaration)

Declaration by Official Veterinarian in the country of origin

I declare that arrangements have been made to ensure that:

- a) after adequate cleansing and disinfection at the place of loading, the means in which the animals are transported are treated with authorised insecticide and/or repellents. This treatment must in any case take place prior to leaving or entering the restricted zone;
- b) [when a rest period of more than one day is foreseen at a control post during the movement through a bluetongue restricted zone, the animals are protected against attacks by vectors in a vector protected establishment in accordance with the criteria in Annex II of Retained EU Regulation 1266/2007;] (*)
- c) insecticide/repellent treatment with (insert name of the product) on..... (insert date) in conformity with Article 9 of Retained EU Regulation No 1266/2007;
- d) the said animals will be transported without coming into contact with cloven hoofed animals other than those of a similarly certified health status.
