

Advice 21-2010 of the Scientific Committee on the optimization of the FASFC analysis program and the attribution of scores for the importance of the microbiological quality and hygiene indicators for the control of food safety systems

During the elaboration of the analysis program, the FASFC uses the procedure “methodology for the elaboration of the official controls of the FASFC” (PCCB/78/2009). This advice contains recommendations for the optimization of the methodology related to the attribution of scores for the importance of the microbiological quality parameters (e.g. total aerobic count) and the hygiene-indicators (e.g. *Enterobacteriaceae*) and draws attention on the importance of the comparison of results of these parameters over the years.
