

Rapid advice 12-2011 of the Scientific Committee of the FASFC of the presence of thiouracil in bovine urine

Following a routine control in the framework of the control plan of FASFC, the presence of thiouracil was detected in a bovine urine sample at a concentration of 15 ppb. Other samples taken during the further investigation were conform. The result of the counter-analysis of the original sample of urine was 29.7 ppb. The interpretation of these non conform results is discussed in relation to recent data from the scientific literature.
